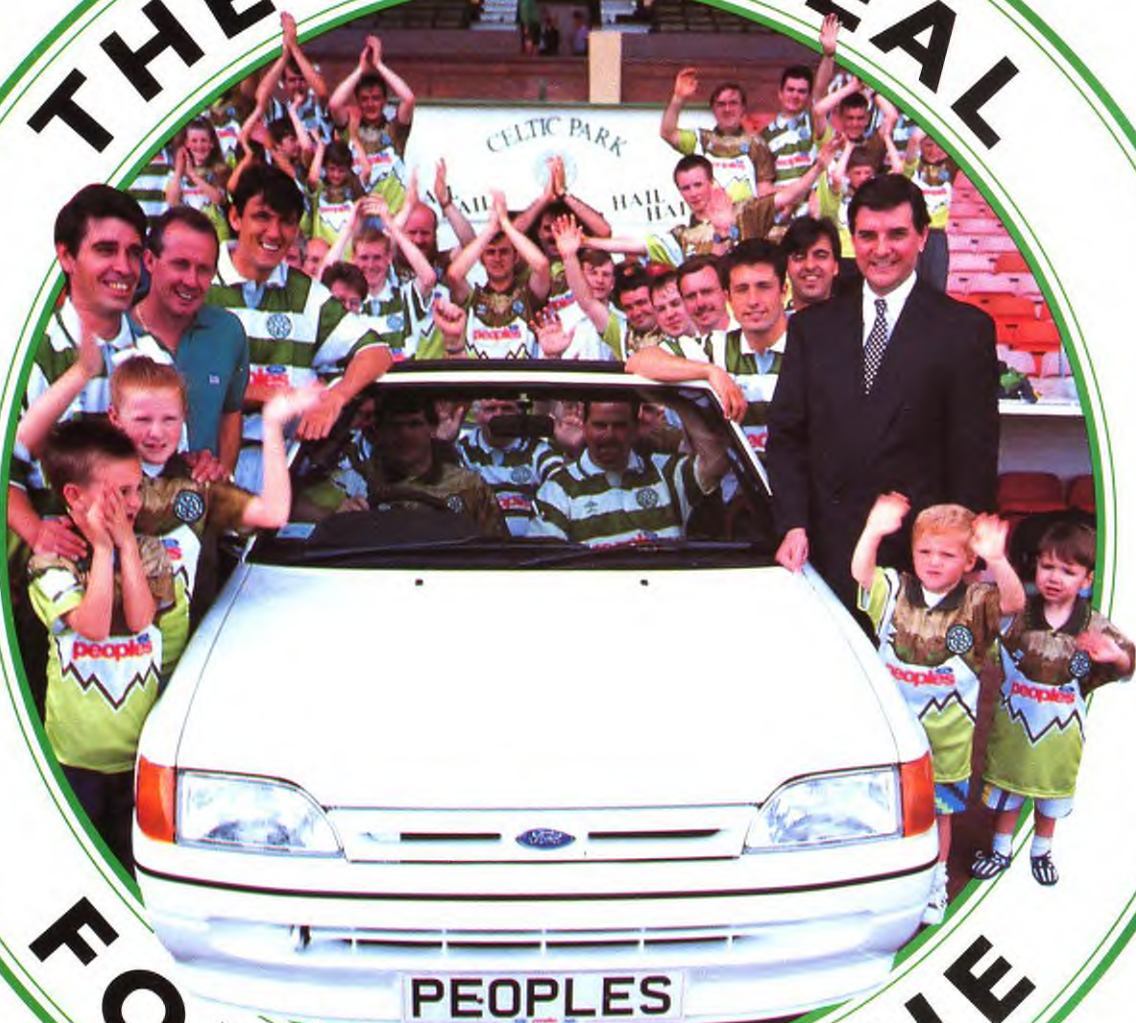

As I have said, our general play has been pleasing if it is a fact that we have not been quite as clinical as we require to be when the chances in front of goal present themselves, as they have on a regular basis in recent matches.

I would anticipate that, if we produce the form of our last two games, we will take maximum points this afternoon.

This being our last home match before Christmas, I would like to take this opportunity to wish all our supporters a happy and enjoyable time over the festive season and hope that we can contribute to it in some small way.

We would urge all supporters to CUT THIS OUT and sing only songs which befit the club's great traditions.

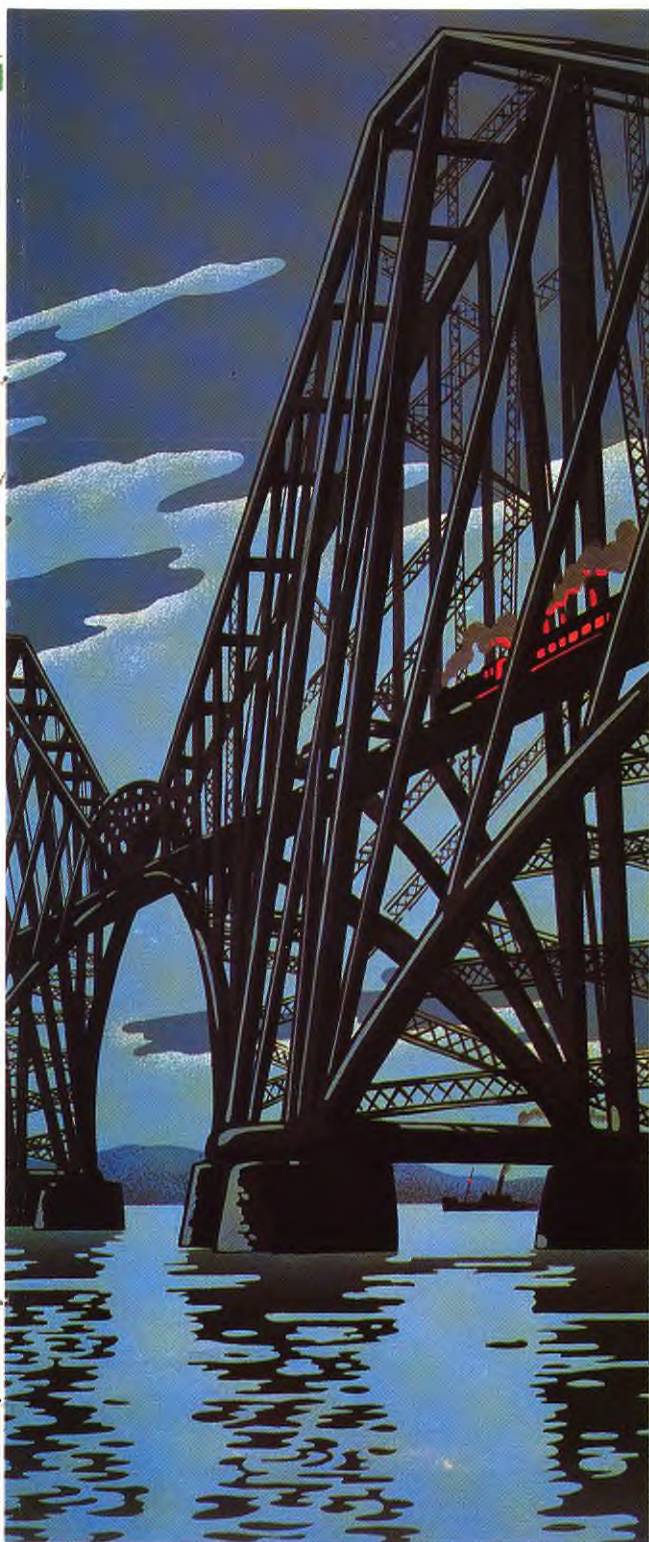

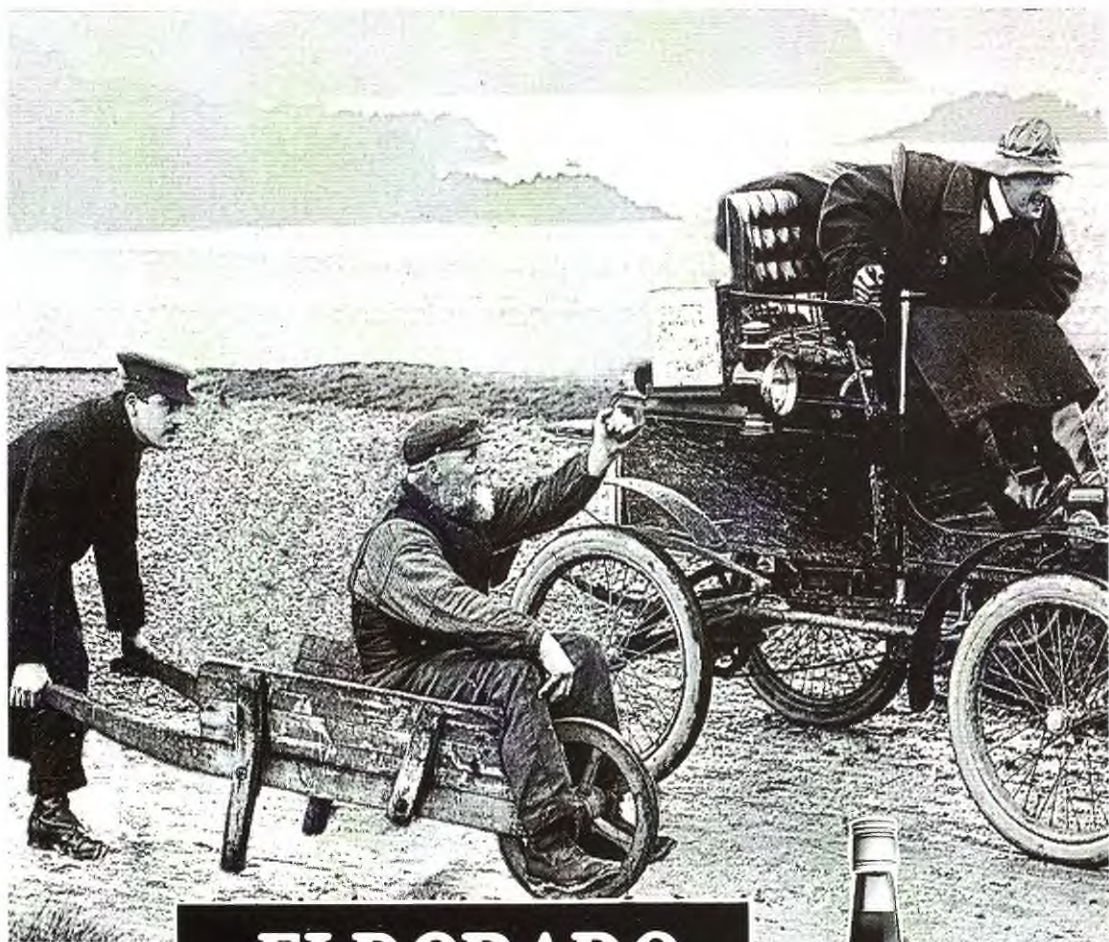

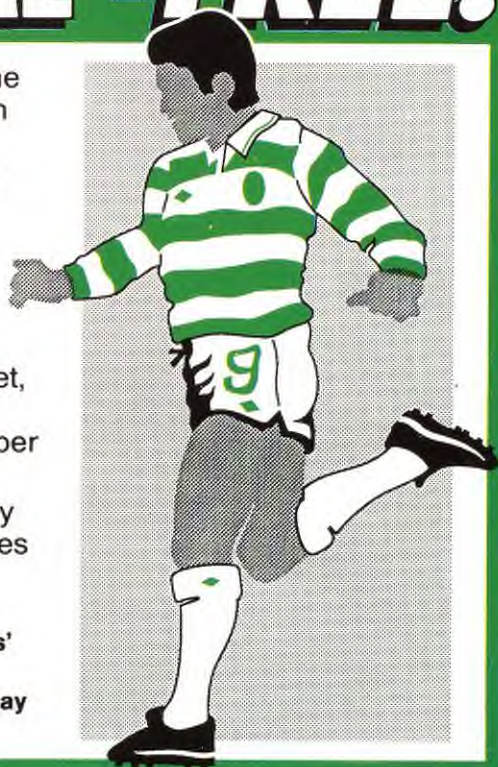
