## FROM THE MANAGER'S CHAIR

TODAY being the last day of The Jungle as a standing area at a Celtic game means this afternoon marks the passing of a piece of history.

I am sure my players will sense the unique nature of the occasion and make sure The Jungle, as it is, bows out in style, with the team producing a performance to be enjoyed and recalled when today is remembered.

Being our final game of the present campaign also we intend to finish a poor season on a high note in any respect.

We will be going about our business determined to give our fans a win over Dundee that will send them away optimistic about what we can achieve next term.

I am certainly very hopeful that we can go on to much better things in 1993/94.

Currently I do not believe we are too far away at all from being a trophy winning side.

The disappointments of this season have demonstrated where our faults lie and we know the work which will be required to ensure success in the year ahead.

Recent years have been very difficult for everyone at the club but I would like to say a big thanks for the backing given to the team by our fans.

Indeed today, when The Jungle is taking centre-stage, I would like to say a special thank you to the supporters who regularly stand in that area of the ground.

None of us have seen the ground buzzing as much as we would have liked in the last two years but when asking for an extra-special effort from supporters it is the hard core in The Jungle I always look to provide a spark of inspiration.

I know those fans have suffered as we have failed to deliver them any trophies in the past two years but they have stuck by me throughout and I am tremendously grateful to them for that.

Indeed it's merely increased my determination to make Celtic a winning team again.

Of course the fans in The Jungle were good to me long before I became manager here.

I played at Celtic Park twice in other team's colours, the first occasion in a pre-season friendly with Arsenal in August 1978 which we won 3-0.

However it was the next time I ran out in front of the Celtic fans that I will forever remember with great affection.

That was when I played for Juventus against Celtic in a European Cup tie in September 1981 in a magical evening in front of a 60,000 full house.

It was my first time back playing on British soil following my Italian move and I didn't know what to expect.

I imagined that the fans would know I was a Celtic supporter because of who I was and where I came from but the reception I received that night, from The Jungle in particular, was simply beyond belief. My family had come over from Ireland for the game and this really made their night. Even though The Jungle as a standing area will become a thing of the past as of next season, I don't think the commitment or spirit - which I experienced in all its glory while playing for Juventus that evening - from fans who watch Celtic from that vantage point will ever be lost.
