WRITING this prior to the Neuchatel Xamax match I can only reflect on our recent progress in the league, which has been very good.

Of course to put ourselves in with a real shout of winning the title we must sustain the form we have recently shown over the coming months.

November was always going to be the acid test of our ambitions with the fixture list pitting us against Rangers, Aberdeen and Hearts in consecutive weeks.

We negotiated the Ibrox hurdle last week satisfactorily but today will be every bit as difficult.

Aberdeen are a quality side and their performance against Rangers at Ibrox earlier in the season, when they played some excellently controlled and measured football to come away with a 2-0 win, was greatly impressive.

It demonstrated what the Dons are capable of away from home and as such I anticipate a very tight match this afternoon.

I have been pleased with the players response to our dreadful performance in Neuchatel because they have shown immense character in recording

the results we have of late and responded exactly the way, as a manager, you would hope they would to a crushing disappointment.

The football we played in the second half against Rangers last Saturday was particularly good.

It was also pleasing to see Tony Cascarino get on the scoresheet and really his lack of goals has been overblown when you consider the actual statistic of how many games he has started.

It is worth pointing out too how much Tony has appreciated the support of the Celtic fans who have been willing him to do well and have really got behind him and indeed the rest of the team in the last few weeks.

Without being too premature things are starting to come together with the squad starting to have a strong look about it.

However I know that in certain areas we are still lacking and where this is the case I will be doing my utmost to improve upon what we have at present by making the correct moves in the transfer market.

BOOK REVIEW

Docherty an authorised biography by Brian Clarke

Published by Kingswood Press. Priced £14.99

AFTER writing three books about himself The Doc has passed the honour onto experienced radio journalist and really it is debatable as to whether this offers any new insight into the topsy-turvy career of one of football's most colourful characters.

The drawback of the book is of course the lack of objective distance provided for a biographer who dissects the life of his subject, under that same person's watchful eye.

Therefore though the book is not a whitewash it never does much more than scratch the surface of what makes Docherty tick, by way of telling his life story.

Which does include a passage about his year or so with Celtic... the passage being all of two pages or so in a 184 page tome, possibly reflecting his limited success with the club.

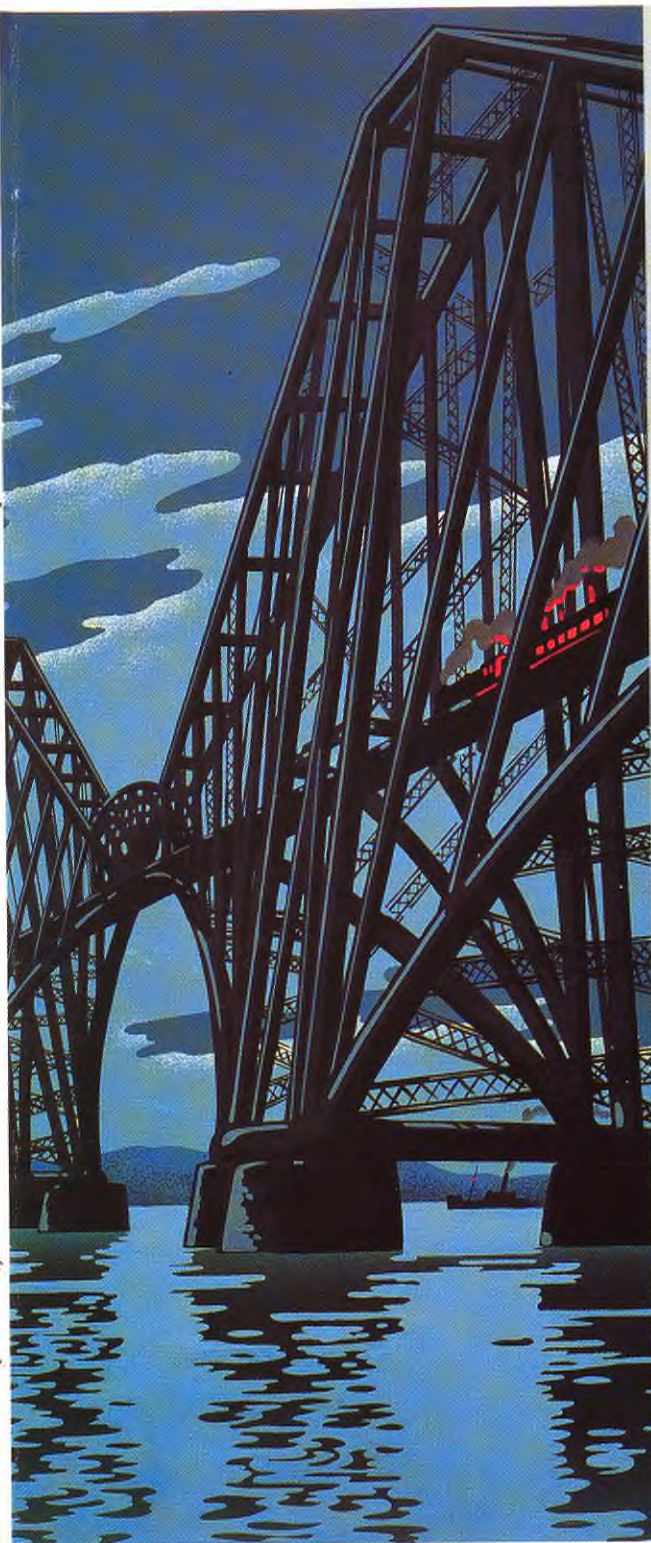

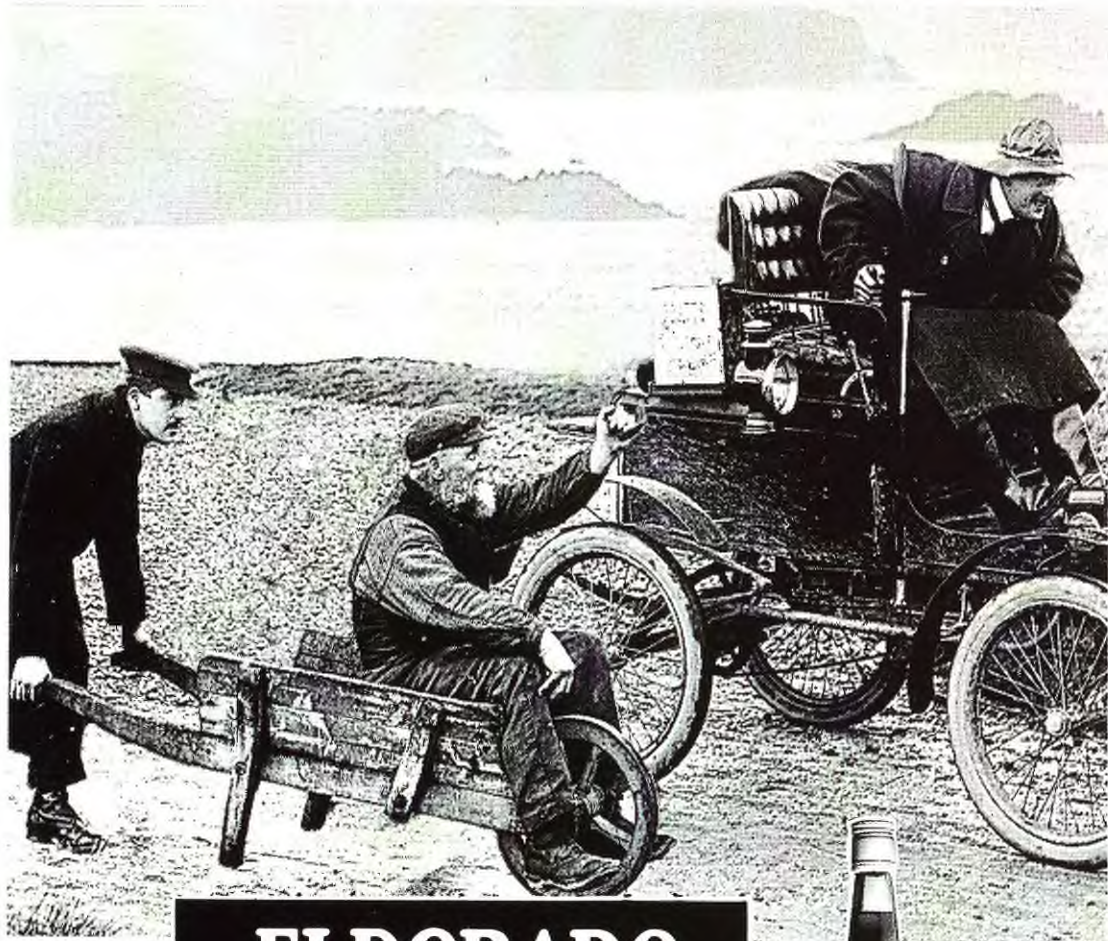

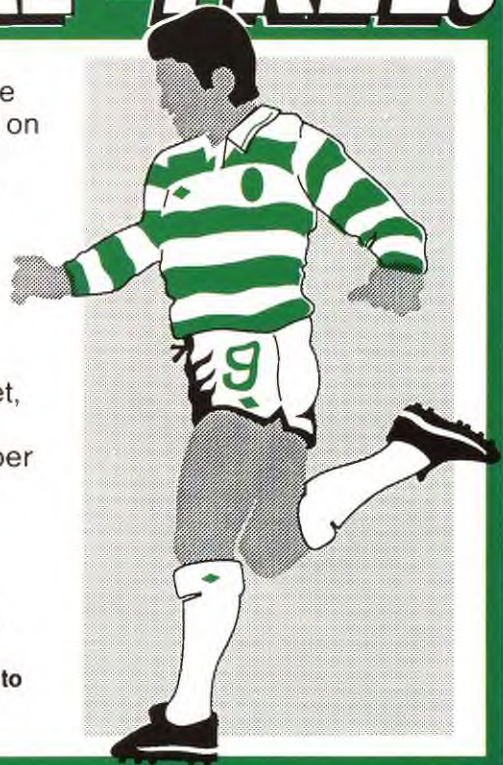
