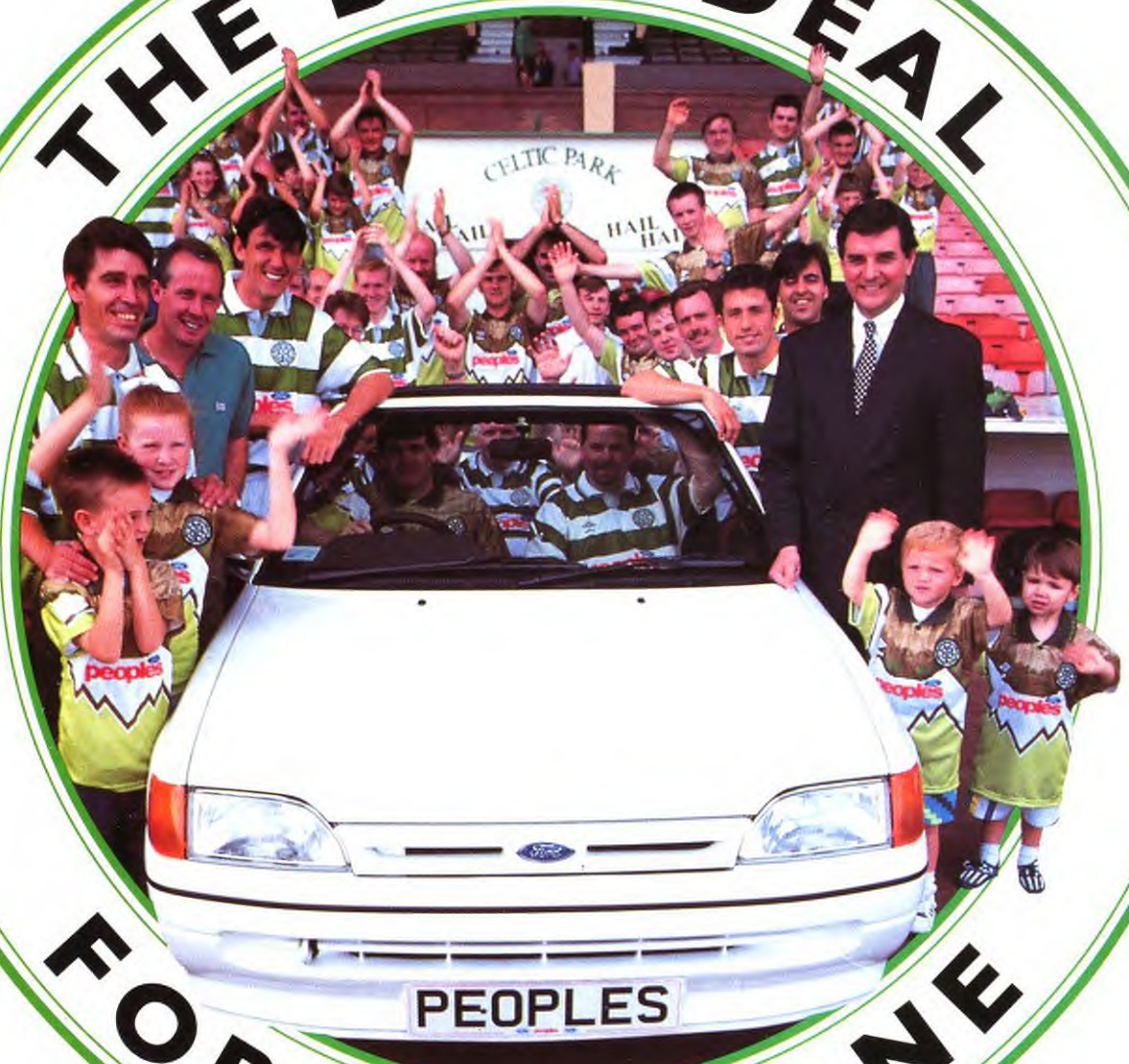

**WE take on St Johnstone tonight seeking to continue where we left off against St Mirren on Saturday where our performance was a very welcome one after the severe disappointment of our showing and result in Switzerland.**

With that in mind, everyone at the club is determined to do his bit in an effort to string together a run of results which will enable us to make up on the ground lost with a couple of disappointing results early on.

With the Neuchatel Xamax performance in mind, we fully understand the deep disappointment which the supporters shared with those of us at the club.

It will take a united effort by both parties to retrieve the situation, which is certainly not impossible, next week.

If ever the vocal support for which Celtic fans are famed is greater than usual then it will surely be in the UEFA Cup second leg tie next week.

Knowing the Celtic supporters' appetite for a challenge, we at the club hope for their strongest backing in the return game with Xamax.

First things first, though, and we have two Premier Division games before then which present us with the chance to make further in-roads on the teams ahead of us in the table.

We will be doing our utmost to ensure that maximum points are gained tonight and then on Saturday to step up our challenge for the top.

## BOOK REVIEW

### THE GUINNESS FOOTBALL ENCYCLOPEDIA

— Edited by Graham Hart. Published by Guinness £14.99.

YET another volume released in time for the Christmas market. Starting with Aberdeen and travelling right through the alphabet to Dino Zoff, this book details every senior club north and south of the border as well as featuring famous players past and present, major league and cup competitions, national sides and the historical development of the game in general.

Among the contributors is Kevin McCarra of Scotland on Sunday and Celts who merit individual entries of their own are Kenny Dalglish, Danny McGrain and Jock Stein.

Ideal for research purposes, the book offers that little bit more than the usual statistics found in the various yearbooks but, selling at around the £15 mark, it may be pricing itself out of the reference market.

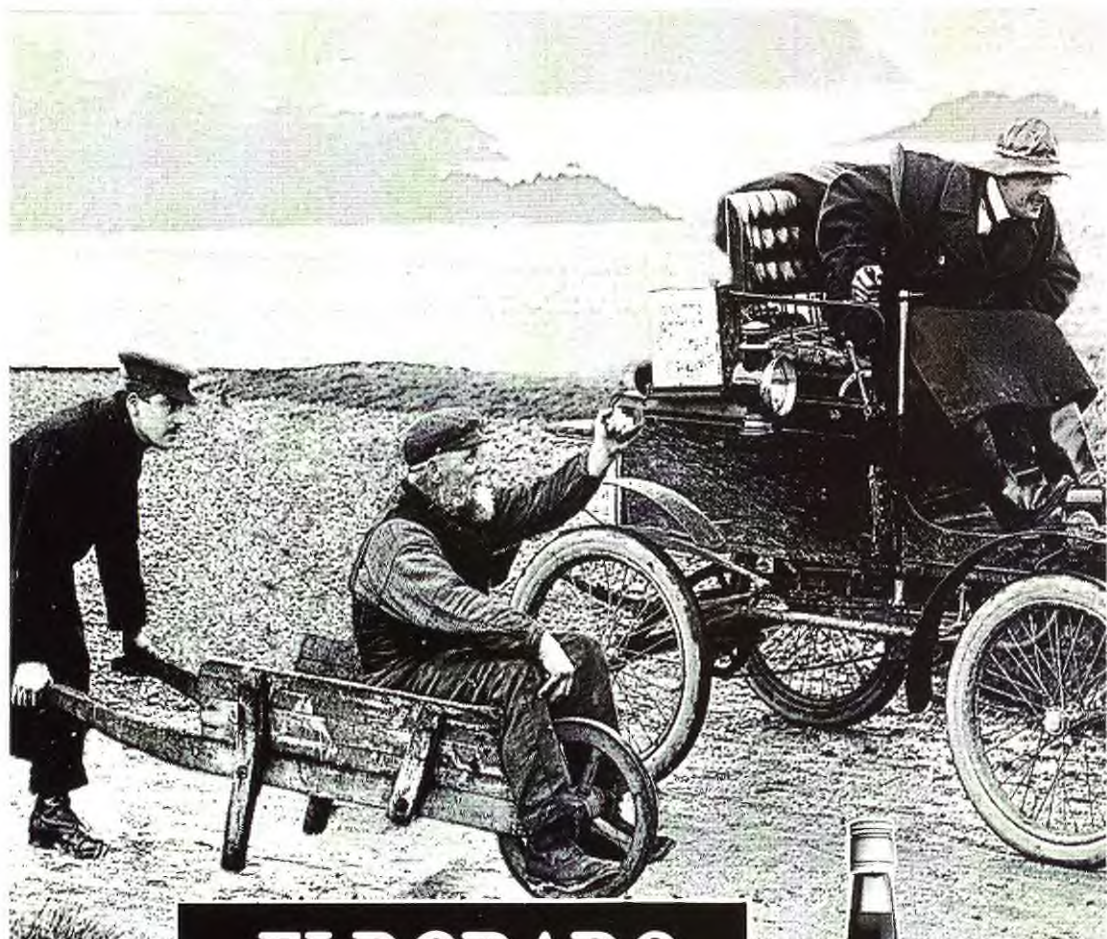
