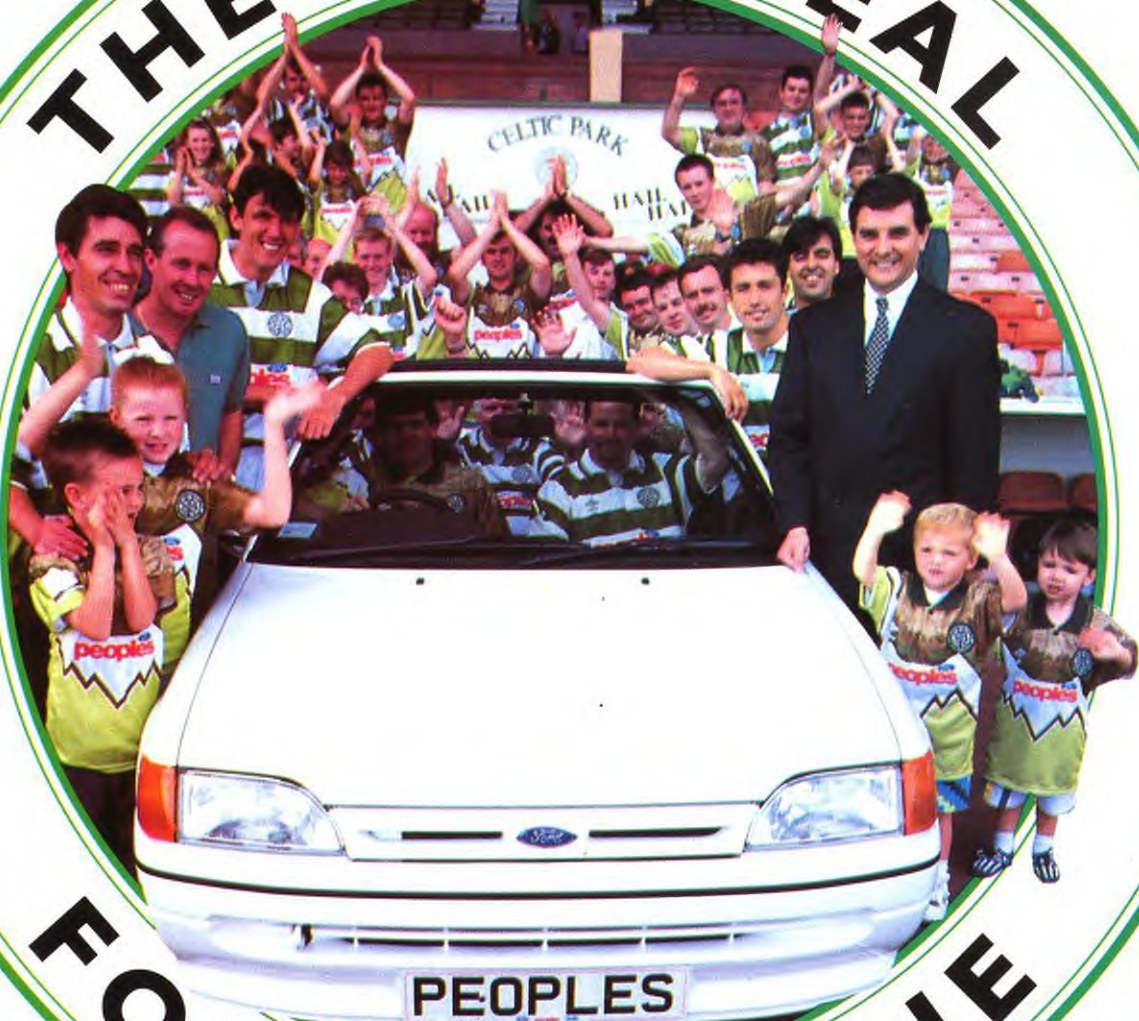

I think we have shown, in our last few matches, that our play is coming together and obviously I was very pleased with the result against Germinal Ekeren in mid-week which secured us a place in the second round of the UEFA Cup.

No-one is claiming it will be easy. It will require plenty of hard work to manoeuvre ourselves into a position whereby we can look forward to prospering both on the domestic and the European front, but I see no reason why ultimately we cannot do so.

It will be a question of instilling self belief and composure into the players, a learning process which undoubtedly requires time.

Obviously support such as we received in Belgium can only help our cause and I would like to thank all those fans who made the trip, very much aware of the great time and money expended on such a venture, and say how much your magnificent backing was appreciated by everyone at the club.

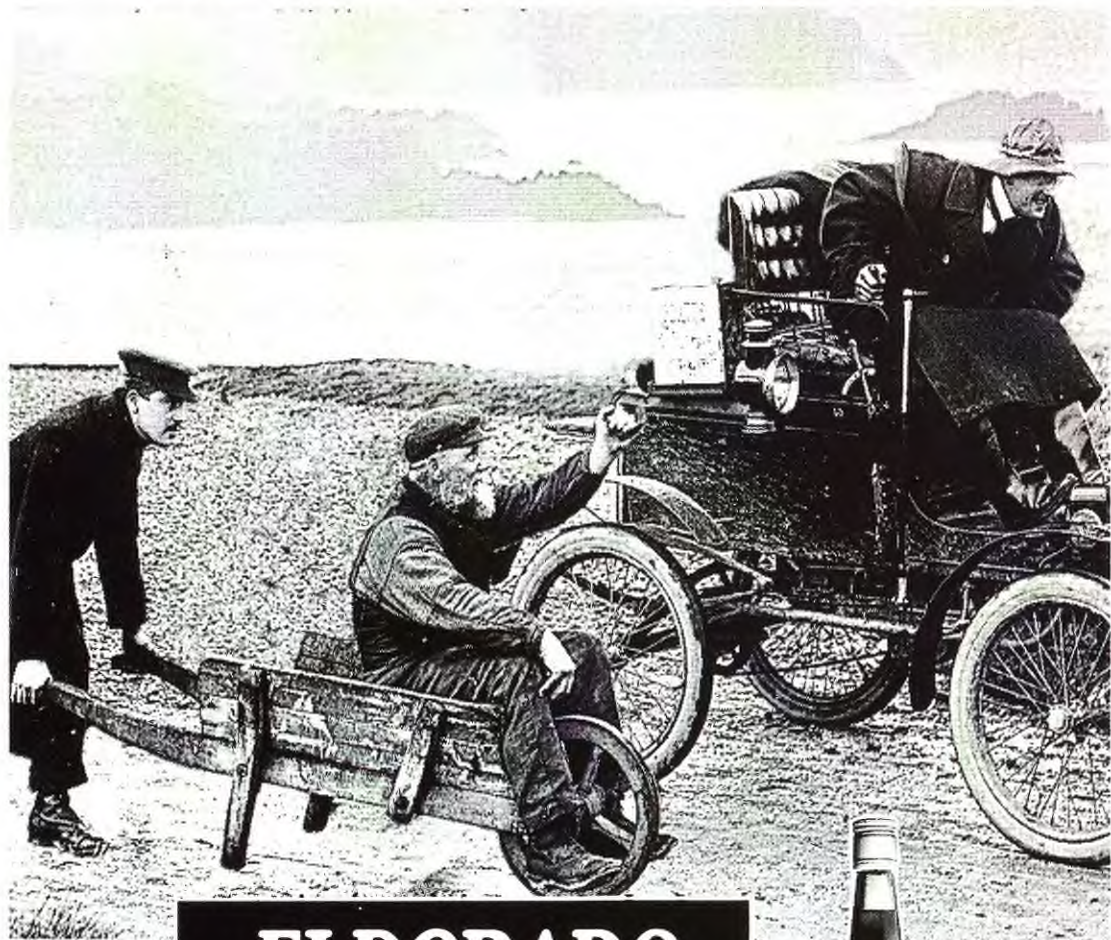
