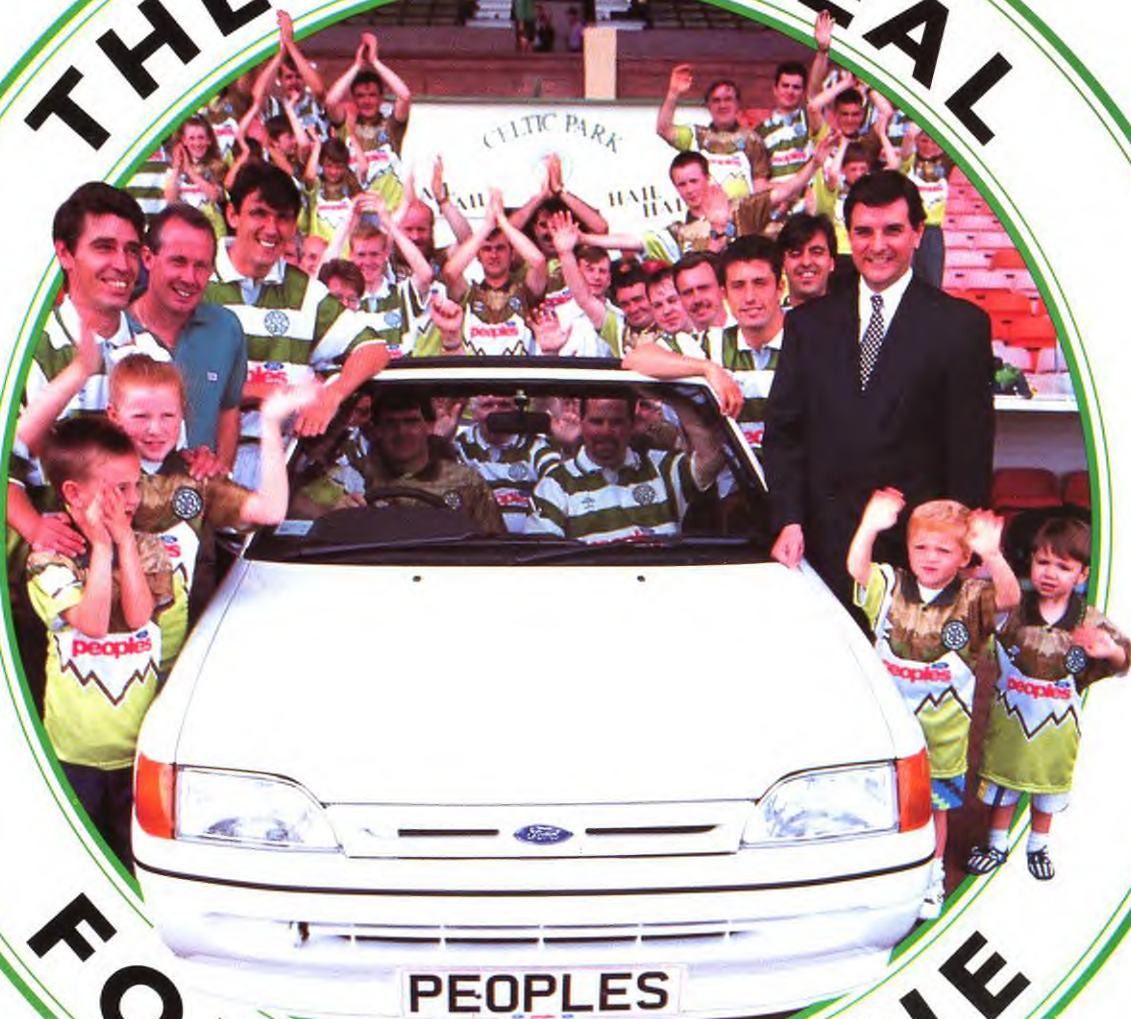

WRITING this prior to our UEFA Cup match with Germinal Ekeren I can only hope that this European match saw us solve the goalscoring problems which have hampered our progress in recent weeks.

For I firmly believe that the only thing which prevented us from taking maximum points in our last two league matches against St Mirren and St Johnstone was our inability to cash in on the numerous chances we created.

In both these matches and also in our Skol Cup meeting with our opponents today Airdrie, we had enough opportunities to kill each of these games off and it is obviously a cause for concern that we did not do so on any of the occasions mentioned.

However while in itself this is far from satisfactory, as far as I am concerned the situation would be far more serious if we were failing to make any chances at all.

At some point these openings WILL turn themselves into goals and it is important that the players do not become frustrated and desperate and start to play a frantic sort of game.

For this not to become the case will depend to a great

extent on the continued backing and encouragement of our supporters in what are undoubtedly difficult and trying times for the club.

The one request I made when I was appointed manager of Celtic was that I asked the media, supporters and others NOT to judge me game to game.

However this is exactly what has happened and I suppose this must be the way of the world in Glasgow.

If that is the case then so be it for I am confident that in the long run we will get things right and that this will become apparent sooner rather than later.

We provided a great scalp for our visitors today, Airdrie, when they eliminated us from the Skol Cup earlier this month and they showed then that they have great battling qualities.

It is up to us though to concentrate on getting our own game right and ensuring that we get back on the winning track in the league.

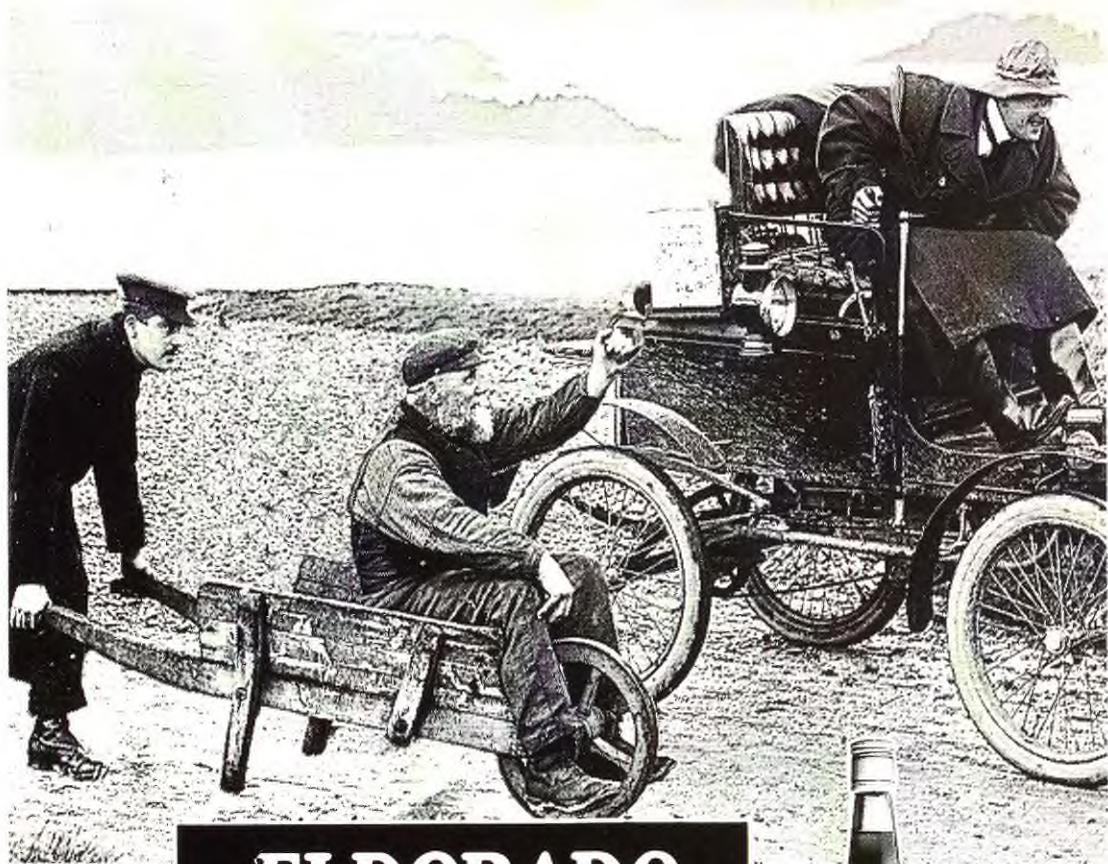

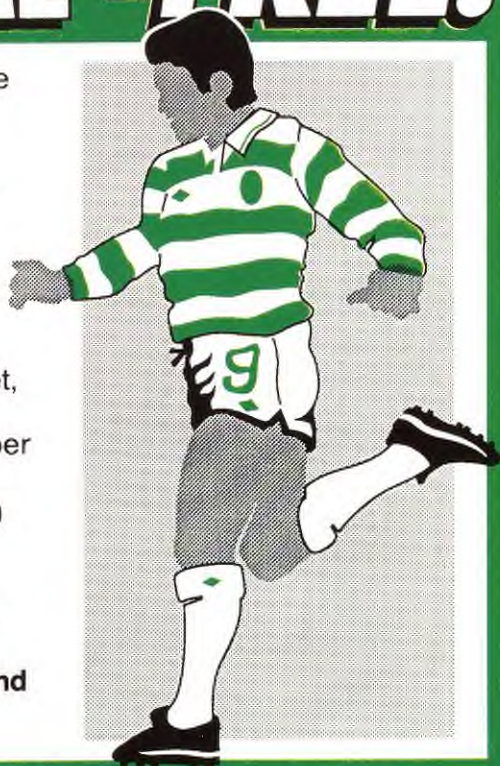
