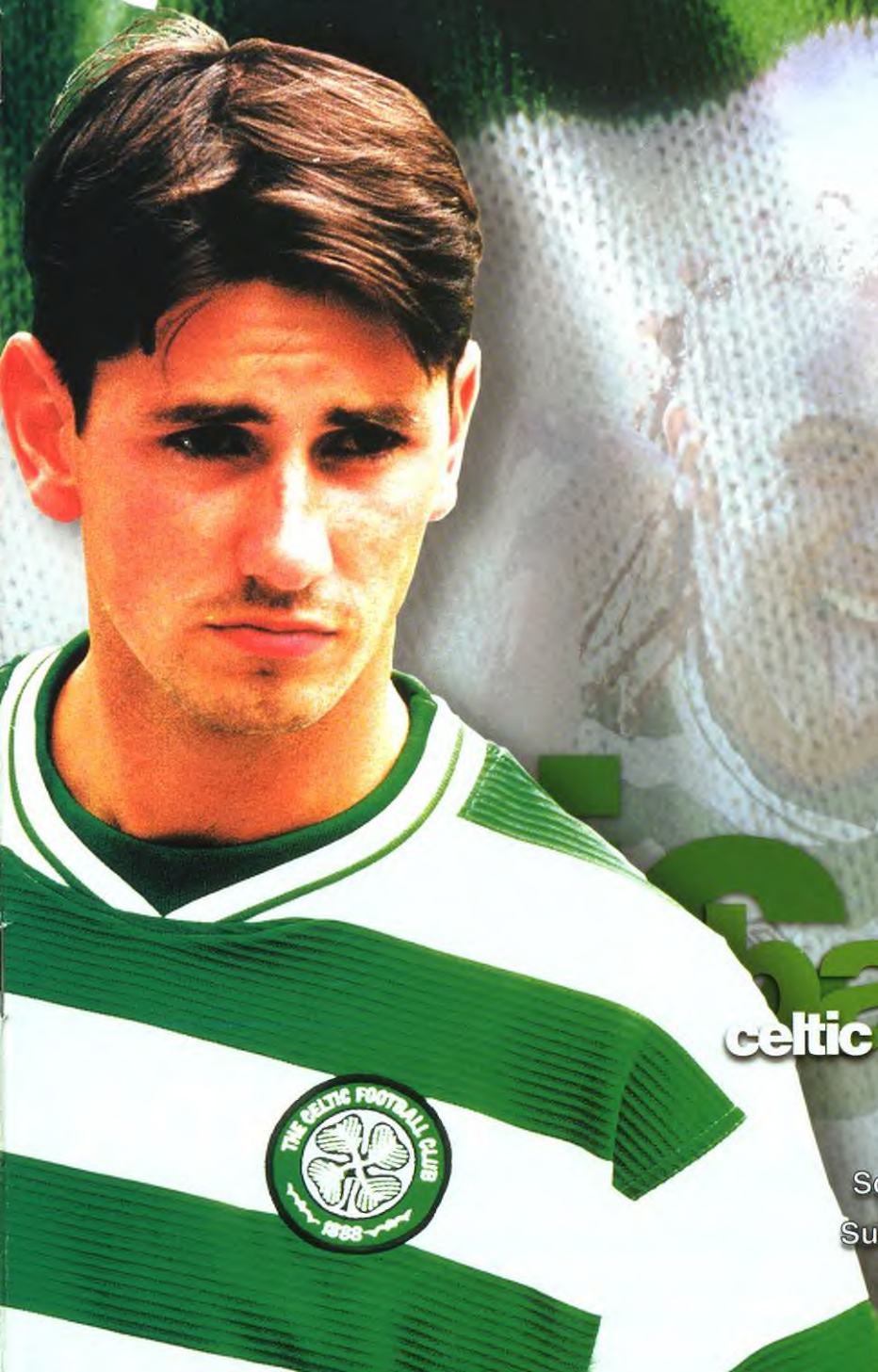

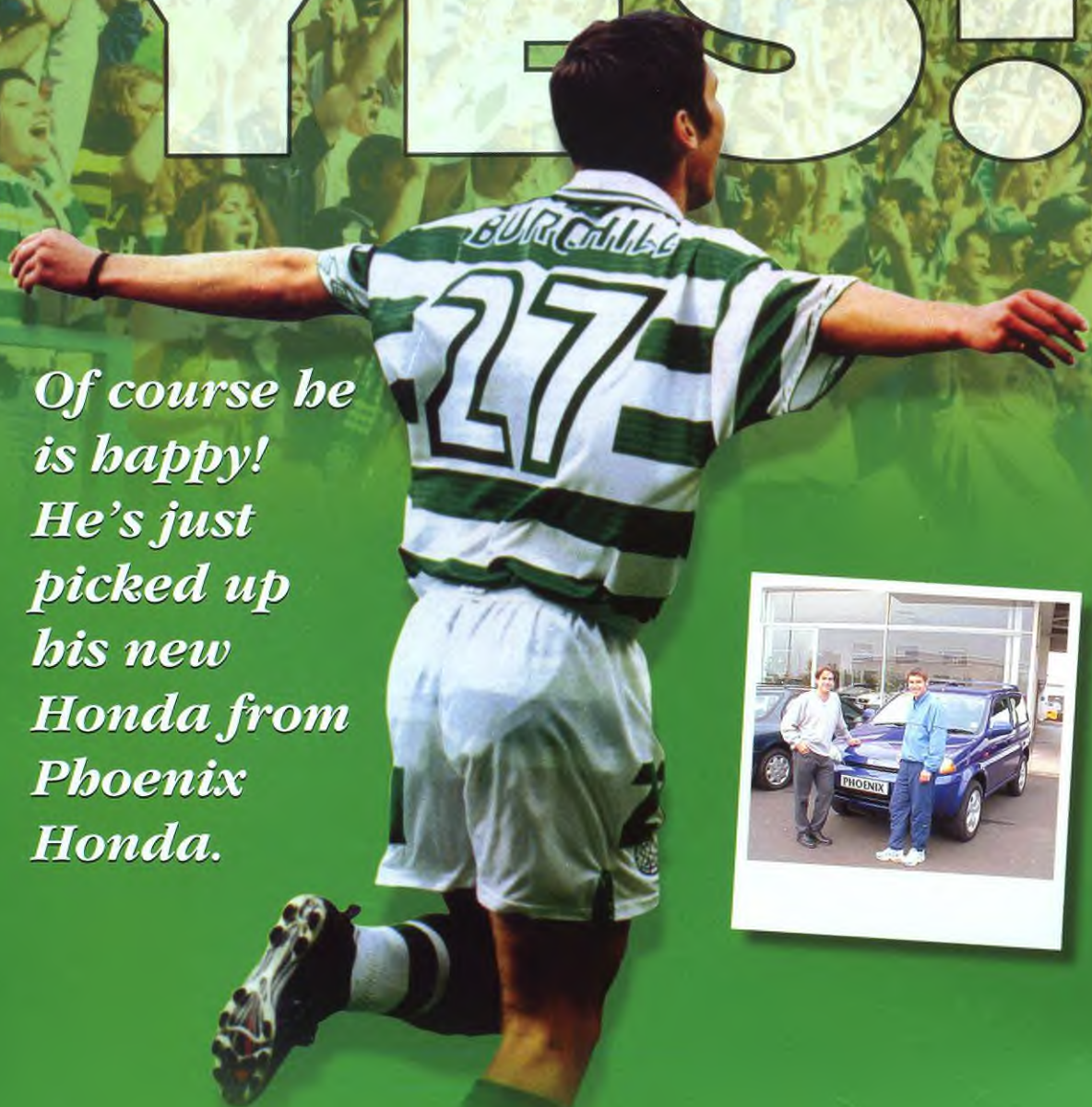

We've had a little bit of criticism to contend with after the last two matches against Dundee United and Dundee.

We have to be disappointed about the result against United. But I thought we dominated the game and created enough chances to have won the match.

You could argue that both of the games on Tayside were scrappy, but I watched them both on video and we created as many chances against both teams as we did against Aberdeen.

When we scored five that night everyone said how great we were and then we scored two against Dundee and all of a sudden it's all doom and gloom.

We should not get carried away by what happened in the 5-0 match at Pittodrie just like we should not get too carried away

after losing at Tannadice and beating Dundee 2-1 away. Why? Because we have to look at the chances created and the way we are playing.

Against Dundee our passing was not as slick, but the pitch had a lot to do with that. Today we are back on our own pitch so I hope our passing will be a bit slicker all round.

If you strip away the meat and look at the bare bones you can see that we still created seven or eight chances against both Dundee and Dundee United.

If we had put even half of them away everyone would have said again we were the greatest thing since sliced bread.

If we hadn't scored late at Dundee we would have drawn 1-1 - but the performance would still have been the exact same.

That's why I'm urging the fans not to pay too much attention to



what the press are saying with regard to our performances, but to look at the facts and see how many chances we are creating.

We have good goalscorers at our disposal and if we continue to create the chances then the strikers will continue to score them.

"We created just as many chances as against Aberdeen"

People were giving odds on the destination of the league after just one game and they had us as favourites because we won 5-0 while Rangers stumbled to beat Kilmarnock 2-1. But now Rangers are odds on - that's football.

We are still bedding down and I cannot understand how we can be the best team ever after beating Aberdeen and St Johnstone and then a bad side after the last two games.

We'll just work on changing that by getting the passing a bit sharper and achieving consistency. Teams will make it difficult for us, as Hearts surely will, but if we keep making opportunities we'll be okay.

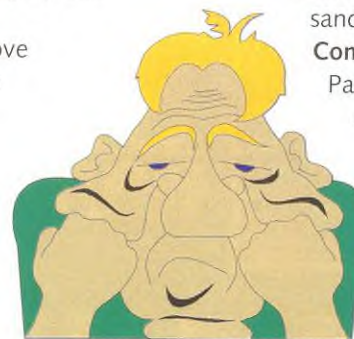

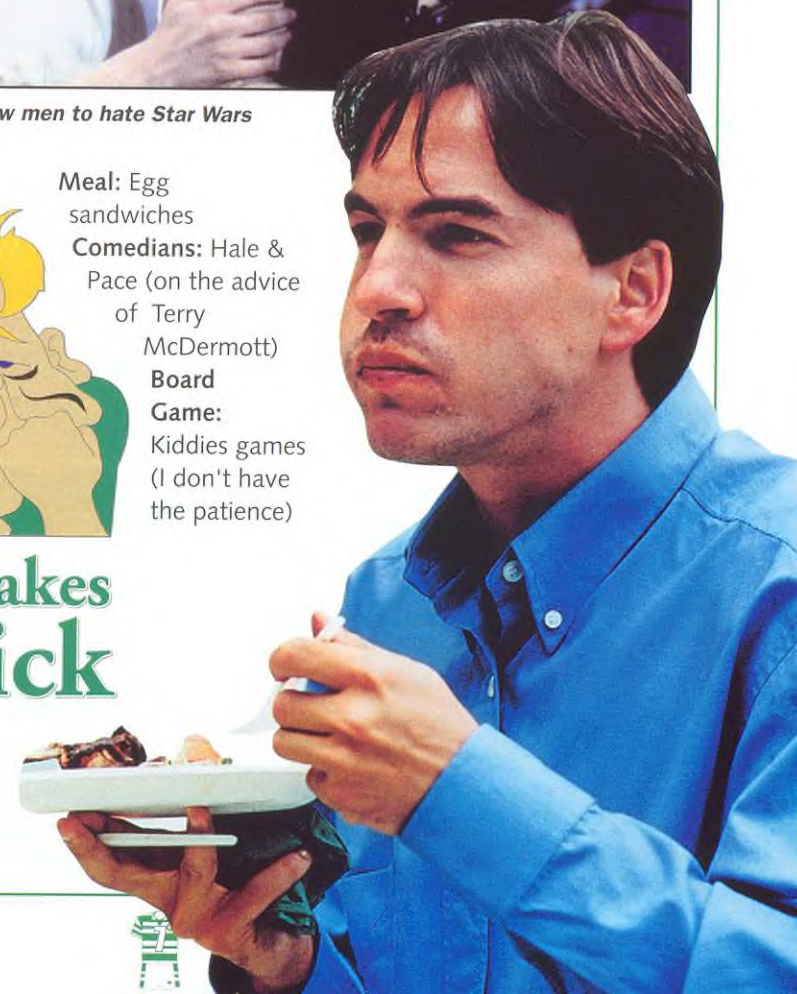
