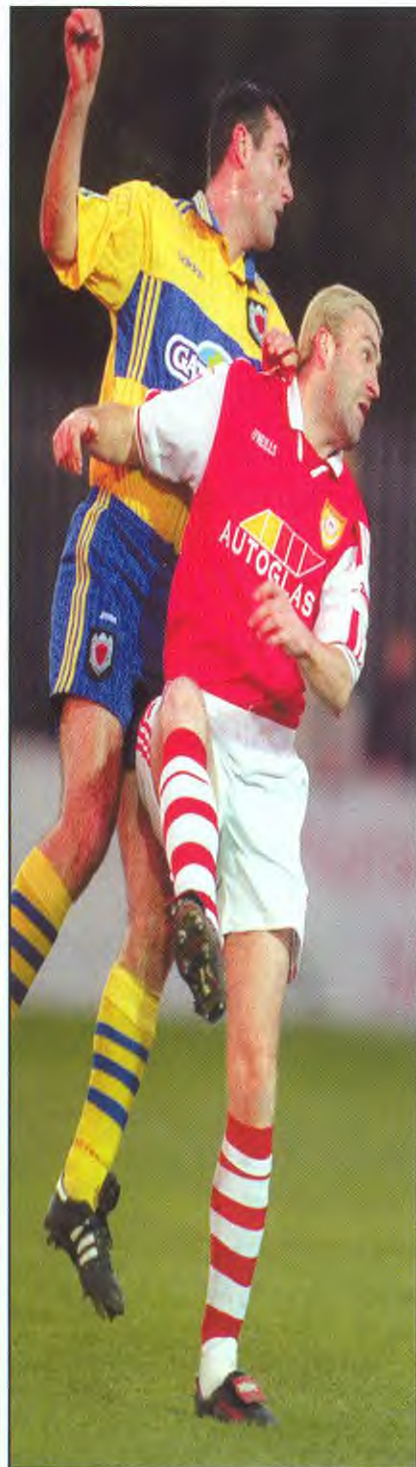

Irish Champions St Patrick's Athletic of Dublin have already entertained a Scottish side this term, playing against Hearts in a pre-season friendly, which they lost 1-0 to the Scottish Cup holders.

Tonight's game is a different kettle of fish however, with both sides vying for a place in the next preliminary round of the European Cup, taking them one step nearer the lucrative money-spinning Champions League.

In goal for St Pat's tonight should be Northern Ireland internationalist **TREVOR WOOD**.

Wood signed last summer from Hereford United and is a firm favourite with The Supersaints supporters.

In season 1997/98 he kept 18 clean sheets in 33 league games and his excellent shot-stopping display against Celtic in last year's pre-season 1-1 friendly sealed his arrival at 'The Stadium of Light'.

In front of Woods on the right of the defence you'll more than likely find **WILLIE BURKE**.

Burke signed from Shamrock Rovers in 1995 and has won the championship twice with St Pat's and once with the Rovers.

On the left will be **KEITH DOYLE**, a current Irish Youth international, who was signed from the famous football nursery of Belvedere during the summer of 1997.

He quickly established himself in the first team despite being only 19.

In the centre of defence will

be **PACKIE LYNCH** and **COLIN HAWKINS**.

Lynch arrived in 1996 and is a remarkably consistent performer.

Hawkins is a current Irish under-21 internationalist who was singled from English Premiership giants Coventry City.

He has astounded coaches and fans alike with his solid performances.

In the midfield you'll find **THOMAS MORGAN**, an another youth internationalist who has a great engine and really came of age last season.

EDDIE GORMLEY is team captain and previous clubs include Tottenham and Bray Wanderers.

One of the most gifted players in Irish football, his silky skills and deft touches at the heart of midfield

make him one of St Patrick's heroes.

PAUL OSAM was a league winner with the club in 1990 and 1996 and previously turned out for Derry City and Shamrock Rovers.

Scored five crucial goals from midfield last season.

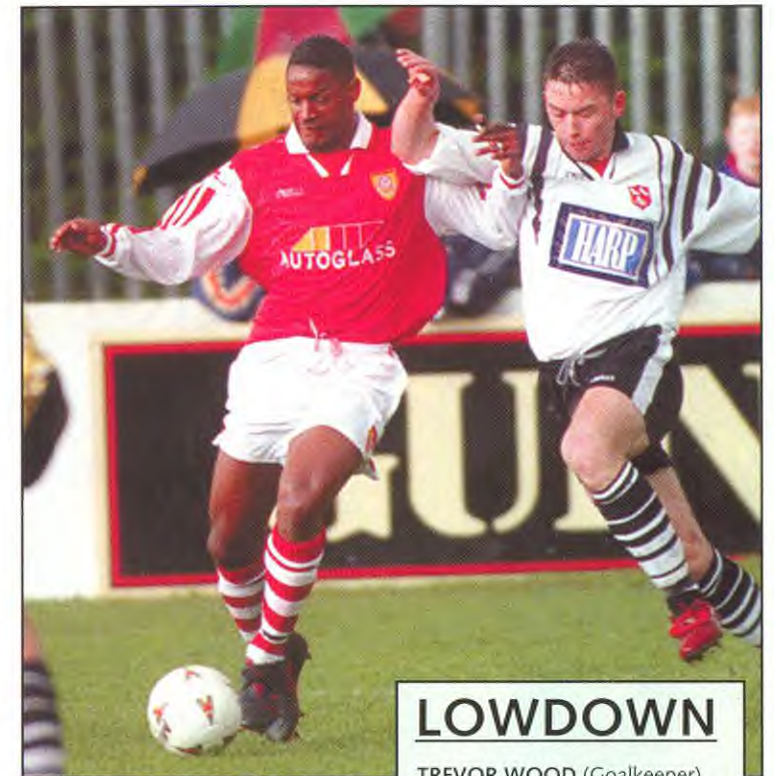
ROBBIE DEVEREUX arrived last summer and is a strong right-sided midfielder who last term played some of his best football since arriving at the club.

Up front for St Pat's is youngster **TREVOR MOLLOY** who impressed Hearts' boss Jim Jeffries so much in their friendly that he expressed a wish to have him in the Edinburgh side.

Another under-21 internationalist, he was leading scorer for Ireland in the World Youth Cup Finals.

Skilful, with great pace, 'Billy Boy' has already endeared himself to the St Pat's supporters with a string of superb goals, including memorable strikes against Cork City and Shamrock Rovers.
