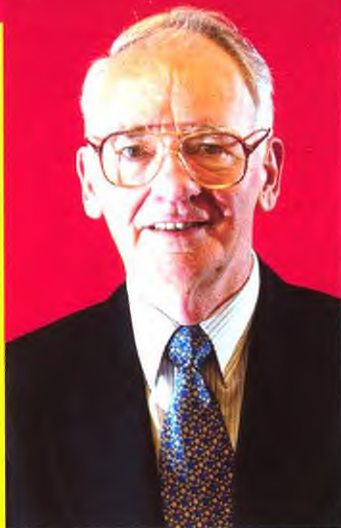

ON BEHALF of the Scottish Football Association, it is my privilege to welcome you to Hampden Park for this afternoon's Tennent's Scottish Cup Final between Celtic and Rangers. This afternoon's match, the 117th final since it all began in 1874, provides Scotland's most successful clubs with the opportunity for a triumphant end to the season. The match will be watched not only by those of you fortunate enough to be part of the capacity crowd here in Glasgow, but also by millions more around the world on satellite television.

It is often said that there is no way of predicting how an Old Firm match will go, but it has never been more true than this afternoon. Honours so far this season have been shared, with Celtic having won the Scottish

Premier League title, while Rangers have the CIS Cup. Both teams have been putting in great performances, with results to match, in recent months.

To retain the trophy today would be an outstanding achievement for Martin O'Neill, who has never yet experienced defeat in a Tennent's Scottish Cup tie. Alex McLeish is, of course, a veteran of Scottish Cup success from his playing days, and had his first experience of a final as a manager last season, when he came here with Hibernian, and he will be striving to get his hands on the trophy today.

This afternoon, the nerves will be fraught but I am sure the skills of both sets of players will shine through and we will see an exciting and memorable match.

I am delighted to welcome, once again, the representatives and guests of the tournament sponsor, Tennent Caledonian Breweries. This is no less than the thirteenth year that this competition has been called the Tennent's Scottish Cup, which highlights the mutually beneficial partnership we have enjoyed over the past decade and more.

To everyone who has contributed to this event, but most of all to you, the supporters, thank you for making today's Tennent's Scottish Cup Final the highlight of the Scottish season. May the better team win!
