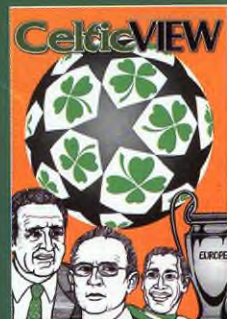

Patience the key to another glory night

TONIGHT we return to UEFA Champions League business with a match against the Norwegian champions Rosenborg.

The experiences in our debut season of this competition have been exhilarating. And after the crushing disappointment of Turin I was delighted that we managed to put three points on the board against Porto.

I never had any fears that the players would recover from their set-back in the Juventus match.

Against the Portuguese, who are very experienced at this level, we claimed a hard-fought 1-0 victory thanks to an opportunistic Henrik Larsson goal.

Now, having more than held our own against two top-class teams, we face another excellent outfit in Rosenborg.

Since the draw for the group stages, I've had Rosenborg watched a number of times and I can assure you they will provide

extremely stiff opposition tonight.

Nils Arne Eggen's side prides itself on team-work and Rosenborg's main strength is they operate brilliantly as a unit.

However, they also possess terrific individuals and flair players who have the ability to cause us problems.

But their strength is unity and our boys will need to be equally unified to emerge with anything.

We go into this match buoyed by some first-class recent results. The victories at Celtic Park against Aberdeen and Porto were achieved with great effort from every player.

Their attitude and application in both matches was faultless and everyone realised we needed to maintain the high standards when we visited Ibrox a week past on Sunday.

Rangers, as we knew they would, made life very difficult. But we coped superbly, rarely


allowing them openings and taking a vital lead with one of Stilian Petrov's trademark thundering free-kicks.

And despite pressure from Rangers in the second-half, we created some excellent chances of our own. In the end, a superb Alan Thompson goal settled it and such an important victory has boosted an already confident dressing-room.

However, the players know it will be very tough this evening. There will be difficult moments when we will not have control of the ball. But I would ask you to remain patient when these come along.

The noise you generated against Porto was absolutely phenomenal, as was the din you created inside Ibrox. That kind of backing is inspirational to our players.

So raise the decibel level again tonight and give our team the loudest of welcomes.
