## All to play for in a night of high drama

**OUR UEFA Champions League section reaches its conclusion this evening with everything still very much to play for.**

Our first ever season in this tremendous competition has undoubtedly proved something of an emotional rollercoaster thus far, but the experience has never been anything less than exhilarating for myself and everyone else at the club.

The players have certainly learned a great deal from pitting their wits against some of Europe's finest players, and tonight will provide yet another massive test of their skill and character.

To give the lads credit, here at Celtic Park they have already shown themselves to be more than a match for our other Group E opponents and, although we have faltered in Portugal and Norway in recent weeks, our unblemished home record will not be given up without a fight.

We will at least be buoyed by the three points Joos Valgaeren's injury-time goal secured for us on Saturday – three points which have allowed us to maintain our

advantage over the chasing pack in the SPL.

Our performance against a well-organised Kilmarnock side lacked many ingredients we have come to take almost for granted here at Celtic Park, but the lads proved once again that they certainly fight to the finish and deserved to win the match. Also, with some players who missed out on the weekend's game back this evening, we should be back to our best.

Put it this way – we will need to be.

Juventus are a world-class team and have proved time and again that they possess the necessary financial clout to challenge for the UEFA Champions Cup. Manager Marcello Lippi is blessed with exceptional players in every department, and no matter who pulls on the famous black and white jerseys this evening, you can guarantee that they will be deserving of the honour.

But although an extremely difficult game lies in store for us, the players have proved often in the past that they are more than capable of rising to even the

stiffest of challenges. Indeed, we only need to look back to the way in which they stormed back from being two goals down to equalise in, and dominate, our first UEFA Champions League match in the Stadio Delle Alpi to re-affirm our belief in their abilities.

I won't need to remind any of you how that match in Turin ended and of the sense of injustice we felt at the outcome. However, that is history and the matter in hand is that of giving ourselves a fighting chance of qualifying for the next stage of the competition.

That is the only thing we retain control over at present and, should Rosenberg spring a surprise in Oporto, it would be frustrating in the extreme if we failed to capitalise.

What I know for certain is that the atmosphere of the European nights here at Celtic Park is everything I thought it would be and more. That is what has made this place so special in the past and I'm sure that, regardless of the eventual outcome of the group this evening, there will be many more nights when it will be so in the future.
