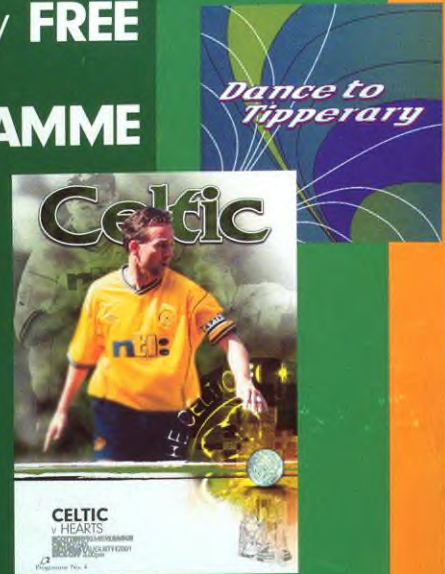

# Feeling champion as Bhoys join Euro elite

**WE had an excellent win over Dunfermline last Saturday. Our players dominated the first half and we deserved to be two goals in front at the interval.**

Jimmy Calderwood's side came more into the game in the second period but I thought we were comfortable 3-1 winners in the end. All three goals scored, two by Lubo Moravcik and the other by Chris Sutton, were top quality strikes and there was some excellent entertainment for the supporters.

People keep telling me we have a stronger squad than last season, but numerically speaking we have less senior players at the moment than we did at the back end of last year. Seven have left and we have brought only four in from other clubs.

Bobo Balde made his league debut for us on Saturday, so all four have started at least one game since they arrived. It will take all of them a little time to adjust to life here but I wanted to bring them to the club to help us in our attempts to retain

the league championship and perhaps upset the odds in European football.

I have the utmost confidence in them all to provide that extra spark needed during the course of the season.

Stilian Petrov returned to first-team action for the first time since breaking his leg against St Johnstone in March. The fact he came back at least two months ahead of schedule speaks volumes for the character of the lad. He got a tremendous ovation from the crowd and did very well during the course of the game.

Joos Valgaeren, too, recovered very quickly from his cartilage operation only two weeks ago and played excellently on Saturday.

As I've said many times before, we will be tested to the limit over the coming weeks and months and I'm hoping we are up to the task ahead.

The opening match of the UEFA Champions League tonight is a massive game for us. Everyone at Celtic has worked exceptionally hard over the last

12 months to get here so we must give it our very best shot.

I know the players are excited by it all and I have to say I'm really looking forward to it myself, but make no mistake, we will not do anything without your help.

When you sensed the danger of the situation during the last half an hour at home to Ajax last month you rallied magnificently behind the players and carried us through. That volume of support will be needed once more tonight, without a shadow of a doubt.

Rosenborg's record in the competition is phenomenal, being the only club to have been involved in every first phase of the competition since it started. It's certainly a wonderful achievement.

Their experience in these matters will be invaluable to them, but tonight we will delve back, at least partly, into our own proud history and will strive to make the Celtic supporters delighted to be associated with the club.
