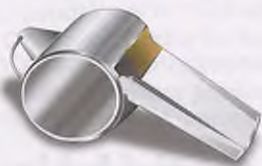

Guimaraes get the needle as record smashed

Tonight's visitors, Vitoria Guimaraes, had the best defensive record in Portugal last term, conceding only 25 goals in 34 games.

Two weeks ago, Henrik Larsson helped Celtic make a bit of a mockery of that statistic, the Swedish goal ace netting after just 50 seconds.

To make it through to the next round of the competition, with the scoreline standing at 2-1 in Celtic's favour, the Portuguese visitors will have to rely more on their frontmen this evening as they look for the two goals that would take them through to the next round.

And of course that's two goals without reply – so the defence will clearly have to do a much better job than they did on their home turf.

Manager **ZORAN FILIPOVIC** will have to play his game as carefully as he can – defending and trying to score twice will

not be an easy task. The man in charge of Vitoria is a tough old thing however, and seems unfazed by what life throws at him. He was sensationally sacked by his last club Boavista when it was discovered that he had taken his wife with him to Milan when his team were playing a UEFA Cup match against the Italians Internazionale.

The resulting 5-1 win by the Neroazzurri was enough to push him out the door, but he didn't help matters when asked about his wife's presence on the trip. He reckoned it wasn't her fault and anyway, better that he took her than his mistress!

A colourful manager indeed, and a man who will be looking for the best from his players tonight as they run out at Celtic Park.

In goal will be 33-year-old keeper **PEDRO ESPINHA** who will undoubtedly be determined to show the world that he is not in the habit of losing goals in the first minute of matches.



Espinha came from SC Salgueiros and is currently in his second term with Vitoria. Vying for a place between the sticks with him is 36-year-old **NENO**. Capped nine times for his country, Neno previously played for Sporting Lisbon and Benfica.

In the heart of the Vitoria defence is the Brazilian **ALEXANDRE** who, at 21, has been playing for his current team for two years. Alongside him in

the middle at the back will be another Brazilian, 25-year-old **AURI FAUSTINO** who has been at the club for the same length of time.

In the left-back position is club captain **QUIM BERTO**, and this Portuguese man of war certainly has a tale to tell.

Guimaraes sold him to Sporting Lisbon for £1million, but he decided he didn't like it there and came back to Guimaraes, who only had to pay £250,000 for him on the assurance that they would pay half his wages and Sporting would pay the other.

At only 25, Quim Berto has been at Vitoria his entire career, except for that few months away last term!

On the right at the back is **JOSE CARLOS**, a 29-year-old in his fourth year here, previously at CF Estrela Amadora. In the

midfield you'll find the man who scored Vitoria's goal against Celtic in the first leg, Brazilian **GERALDO**, who arrived in Portugal last term.

A more defensive midfielder than Geraldo is **PAIVA** who is one of the visitors' best players. A 25-year-old Portuguese who came from CS Maritimo, Paiva has a lot to offer.

On the right of the midfield there is one to watch in **VITOR PANEIRA**. This former Benfica captain is a dead-ball expert and should be watched closely.

Capped over 40 times for Portugal, this 32-year-old is by no means finished yet.

Also available in midfield are Yugoslavian **BRANKO MILOVANOVIC** and **PAULO GOMES**, a native of Portugal. Milovanovic has had a pretty bad time of it recently, frozen out after a dispute with his club, he

was on the bench in the last leg and featured for the last 10 minutes only. **SVEN FREDERICK OLOF SODERSTROM** is not Portuguese, you might have guessed, and this Swede is in his third term with Vitoria also. A left midfielder who was also on the bench in the last leg.

COSTA completes the midfield parade – he's a 24-year old formerly with Porto.

Up front there are yet more Brazilians, **RIVA** who has been capped three times at under-16 level, in his third season with the club.

Then there's **GILMAR** who is in his fifth season at the club, and has scored in the UEFA Cup in the 1995/96 and 1996/97 campaigns.

EDMILSON may sound Brazilian but he's Portuguese and he's 30-years-old. Before arriving at Vitoria last term, he spent six seasons at Maritimo.
