# WE ARE ON THE RIGHT ROAD

I AM delighted to welcome the FA Cup-holders Tottenham Hotspur to Celtic Park in what will be my first home match since taking up the post as manager of Celtic Football Club.

Having played the English champions at Highbury on Tuesday, it is appropriate that we should now test ourselves against their great North London rivals, the cup winners.

I am sure that the game will be a really entertaining affair between two sides with attacking traditions. Certainly, no-one will be complaining if it matches up to the entertainment provided by both sides in the testimonial game for Paul Davis on Tuesday.

Our performance in that match left me feeling confident that we are on the right road. The players have a good attitude and are working very hard.

The Celtic supporters who travelled down and made the night such a special one for Paul Davis must have been encouraged by what they saw and I hope that they took back good reports and come along again today in large numbers.

It was also a very big night for Charlie Nicholas and he thoroughly enjoyed the occasion. His attitude is

right and so is his weight. He has plenty to offer Celtic in the months ahead.

However, I was very pleased with the contributions of all the players in the game, even though a couple of wrong decisions in defence meant that we lost goals which might have been avoided.

The injury suffered by Derek Whyte was also a blow, particularly as we are not well covered in that department. However, the initial X-ray indicated that there was no serious damage.

Whether he would be out for any length of time was not clear at the time of writing.

Overall though, there were far more plus points to Tuesday's performance than disappointments so we can look forward with confidence.

Playing games against quality opposition such as Arsenal and 'Spurs enables me to find out much more about my players than low key games against minor opposition.

So today can be another significant learning experience for me as well as a thoroughly enjoyable occasion for the fans.

LAST Tuesday night at Highbury gave us further proof, if indeed we needed any, that Celtic are top of the list when it comes to players choosing the opponents for their testimonial match.

The occasion was the testimonial for Paul Davis of Arsenal and, depending on what paper you read, between 12,000 and 17,000 Celtic fans travelled south to boost the gate and make it a very happy and memorable, not to say financially rewarding, night for the Arsenal star.

As they had done for players like David O'Leary, Jack and Bobby Charlton, Bryan Robson, Bobby Moore, Sammy Nelson and Lou Macari the Celtic fans turned the night into a carnival celebration and returned home with plaudits abounding from both press and Paul Davis alike.

If there was ever a testimonial due to be played for supporters then surely the recipients would be the Celtic fans.

## HELPING THE GAME

The Football Trust 1990 has been created to help the game at all levels and to assist clubs meet the requirements of Lord Justice Taylor's Final Report.

Safety and comfort for all spectators is the primary objective and substantial funds have been made available for the provision of seating at Scottish Football League grounds. At the same time the Trust's commitment to family and community initiatives will continue with the provision of more family enclosures, better toilet facilities, covered accommodation, artificial pitches for local use and the development of junior football, plus a wide range of policing and crowd control measures.

Each year the Trust expects to receive £20 million from the reduction in Pool Betting Duty plus the £10 million continuing contribution from the Spotting-the-Ball competition organised by Littlewoods, Vernons and Zettlers. This money will be invested in projects which benefit football throughout the United Kingdom.
