John Divers was our other scorer in this 5-1 win which is the biggest ever score by a visiting team at Firs Park.

The match was marred by the ordering off of Billy McNeill and the injury to him and later to McQueen of East Stirling. Our team are usually very well disciplined so surely something must have occurred to cause the protests.
