far, our biggest "gate" this term has been the 14,000 who saw us against Rangers at Shawfield in August last in the League Cup but Celtic's visit this afternoon should see these figures well beaten.

The attendance against Rangers in the league at Shawfield a fortnight ago was 13,000. Clyde rose to the occasion in really heartwarming fashion to deprive the "Light Blues" of a point they may bitterly regret at the end of the season. Oddly enough, an analysis of Clyde's playing record to date shows that the club does much better in away games than those at home! It is incredible but true.

Of the 15 points standing to our credit, six have been garnered at home and nine
