We all hope that Charlie Tully makes his comeback for Celtic today. For the bold boy from Belfast is also a wonderful player to watch, whether you support his team or not.

Then there's wee Bobby Collins, that bundle of dynamite who has had such a wonderful international career, despite his lack of inches.
