CLUB NOTES

Our welcome visitors today are Airdrieonians, and while we cannot now qualify for the later rounds of the League Cup, our boys will be out to avenge that 4-2 defeat inflicted by the Waysiders at Broomfield Park. If we maintain the form shown in recent home games then there should be no doubt about the result.

Against Raith Rovers the score was 1-0 but might well have been more but for the magnificent display of goalkeeper Drummond who had a really splendid game. Undoubtedly he had a goodly share of luck, but he deserved it. From our point of view the most gratifying thing this season is the displays of the boys who have made their debuts in the First eleven and it is most satisfactory to find them able to fill the bill when called on. Confidence is an essential factor in the make up of all first class footballers, and our supporters can play a vital part in helping to mould these stars of the future by encouraging them when they warrant it and by refraining from loud mouthed criticism when things are not running for them. Players know only too well when they are having a bad game and shouting abuse

at them will not help, but may undermine this confidence which is so important.

In spite of many enforced changes the Reserves have won all their five games in the League Cup, scoring 28 goals for the loss of 5. This is a very fine performance, and the skill and enthusiasm displayed by this team has been most pleasing. Football in Scotland has suffered a great loss by the tragically sudden death of Mr. David Meiklejohn, Manager of Partick Thistle. He was one of the greatest of Rangers players and also one of the best Captains of Scotland's International team. We take this opportunity of conveying to his widow and family the most sincere sympathy of all at Celtic Park in their great loss.

On September 5th we meet Rangers at Ibrox Park in a Scottish League game. Admission to this match will be by ticket only. The Directors of Celtic F.C. again appeal to all spectators to be on their best behaviour, and wish to make it clear that the Police will have their wholehearted support in taking whatever measures, however stringent, they consider necessary to maintain order on this occasion.
