The Scottish Football Association and The Scottish League Management Committee have stated that the Scottish Cup and Scottish League should be re-organised with the view of providing better football for the spectators. The ideal for the Cup would be to have a First Round of 32 Clubs, which would avoid having any byes. In order to get this number the 18 First Division and the top 6 of the Second Division could be exempt and the remaining 8 places would be played for by all the others.

After seeing Slovan Bratislava at Celtic Park on Wednesday, it is not without reason that they are considered to be among the top Clubs in Europe. It was a very hard match in Glasgow and we don't doubt that it will be an equally hard match in Czechoslovakia. Luck did not run kindly for us but we must compliment the players in their non-stop aggressive attacking football.

Given similar endeavour by our players in Bratislava we could still hope to go into the ballot for the Semi-final of the European Cup.
