EXTRACT FROM FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION RULES

The proceeds of any pre-season Practice Matches between teams of the same Club or between teams of different Clubs, which are played during the fourteen days immediately preceeding the playing season with the consent of the affiliated Association or Associations concerned, must be distributed before the 15th September, 1969, as follows:—

- (1) 10 per cent to the Football Association for a Fund for the Development of Youth Football, from which the Association will make grants to any County Youth Football Association, Committee or Youth Competition requiring financial assistance.
- (2) Not less than 25 per cent to the County Associations to which the Club or Clubs are affiliated.
- (3) Any balance of the net receipts left after payment referred to in paragraphs (1) and (2) of this Rule will be used or distributed in such manner as the Club or Clubs shall decide.

Before the above distribution is made, the essential ground and travelling expenses of the match may be deducted from the gross receipts but these deductions shall not exceed 20 per cent of the gross receipts.
