Notes and Comments

We are trying to work the shock of that Cup defeat out of our system. And "work" is definitely the operative word. Our supporters were badly let down by the way in which we were tossed out of the national competition. We know it and the players know it. A complete lack of professionalism by our players in their approach to the serious job on hand was entirely responsible for this dismal result. The outcome is that our Cup bid is over before it had hardly begun.

The tie should never have gone to a replay. We had more than enough chances to clinch it. Instead, we let Raith Rovers off the hook. The 2-0 advantage which we held early in the second half should have been quite sufficient to take us into Round Two. That's when the lack of professionalism was seen, unfortunately. Our midfield players and full-backs all wanted to get into the attacking act. By so doing, they neglected their primary function — to keep the other fellows out. Raith expressed their thanks for the gaps by grabbing an unexpected replay chance.

Spirit Won This Game

Commenting on the replay itself, manager Ormond says — "I was bitterly disappointed. Our players didn't even match Raith in spirit, and it was spirit which won this game. No First Division side should score three goals against Second Division opposition and lose. Our defensive blunders could not have proved more costly. This was one of the worst defensive displays I have seen since coming to Muirton."

Mr Ormond adds — "If the players had only shown half the spirit they produced against Ayr United four days later, we would be looking forward to a home tie with Clyde. At Somerset Park they played as a team, covering each other and always ready to help each other out. The defenders were doing their job, allowing the attack to do likewise."

Falkirk's Visit

Last Saturday's 3-1 win established us in fourth place — one point ahead of our nearest rivals, Falkirk, who drew with Dundee. We have arranged to play our postponed League game with the Brockville side next Saturday and this game, along with our match against Celtic, is crucial in our bid to remain near the top of the Division.
