FROM THE MANAGER'S DESK

Celtic are through to the first round proper of the European Cup-Winners Cup. We made certain of progressing with the big win in Holland, where we played before one of the most sporting crowds possible. The Deventer people had been warned by the scouts who watched us beat Aberdeen 7-1 that they would have a very hard job and would not have much of a chance of winning. But to Go-Ahead's great credit they did not attempt to close the match up but played an open type of game.

All in all, this was a most enjoyable trip and we retain very pleasant memories of the Go-Ahead club and their supporters. We hope we have in some way returned their kindness and hospitality in the second leg at Parkhead.

The great quality of the play in the League Cup semi-final at Ibrox last Monday has perhaps not had the publicity it deserved, thanks to the controversy about the venue for the replay. This Celtic versus Hibs match had everything, fast and often skilful play, 22 players giving their all for their clubs, and (for Celtic supporters!) a wonderful 90th minute equalising goal by Bobby Lennox.

There is no reason why the clubs should not again delight the spectators when the replay takes place on October 18th the Monday of the week in which the final is due to be played.

The Scottish League Management Committee have reaffirmed their decision that the replay will be at Ibrox Stadium, despite the wishes of both the contesting clubs.

I must point out that Celtic acquainted the ruling body of their disappointment that the semi-final had been fixed for Ibrox, long before the game was played, the main cause of our dissatisfaction being that we did not consider the game would be witnessed under the best possible conditions and each club was entitled to play on the venue the final would take place.

Further reasons for wishing the game to go on at Hampden have been given by both Celtic and Hibs. The supporters of both clubs know that Hampden is more accessible and provides a better get-away after a match than Ibrox.

Well, the League Management Committee have said "No" to us without, in our opinion, having given one good reason for sticking to their decision.

I respectfully draw their attention to one of the rules of constitution of the Scottish League. Number 3 states:

"The objects of the League shall be to promote and extend the game of Association Football, to provide League Championship and League Cup competitions for and to guard the interests of the clubs comprising the League."

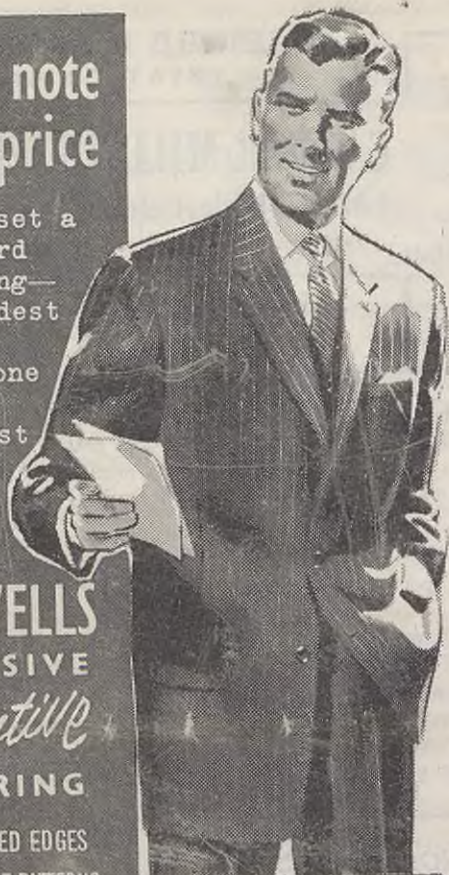
