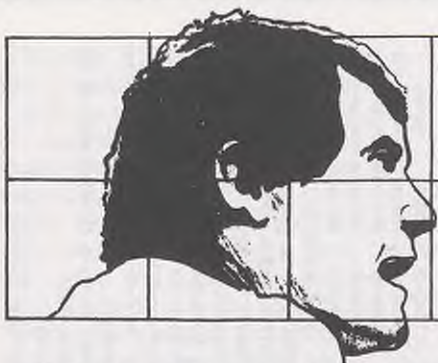

# Archie Knox

In our last three matches things have been going along nicely and the team has played some good football. We have to ensure that we keep this approach going. Against Hibs we converted three chances and made many more, some of which we should have capitalised on but at the end of the day we got both points.

We then dropped a point at Motherwell but considering that we lost two early goals the team did well to come back into the game. Then last Saturday we made the trip North to Nairn and came away with a good result on a pitch that could have caused us more difficulties.
